




About Us



He has won the Black Film Critics Circle Rising Star Awards, Ghana Movie Awards Best Actor in a Leading Role and Discovery of the Year, Independent Spirit Award for Best Male Lead, National Board of Review Award for Best Breakthrough Performance and Venice International Film Festival Marcello Mastroianni Best Young Actor Award.

Some of the Prestigious awards he has been Nominated for include Gold Derby Film Award for Best Breakthrough Performer, Awards Circuit Community Award for Best Performance by an Actor in a Leading Role, Critics' Choice Movie Award for Best Young Performer, NAACP Image Award for Outstanding Actor in a Motion Picture, Screen Actors Guild Award for Outstanding Performance by a Cast in a Motion Picture, St. Louis Film Critics Award for Best Actor, Washington D.C. Area Film Critics Association Award for Best Youth performance and Empire Award for Best Male Newcomer.

Dr. Ahmed Adamu was elected on November 12, 2013 as the first-ever Global Chairperson of the Commonwealth Youth Council (CYC), which is the largest youth-led organisation in the world, representing over 1.2 Billion young people from across the 53 Commonwealth nations worldwide. He represented his country in many international and commonwealth youth programmes, and was the pioneer Chief Whip of the Nigerian Youth Parliament.

He is currently a University Lecturer, Development and Planning Consultant at the Umaru Musa Yar'adua University.

He was an International expert at United Nation's Global Forum on Youth Policies; Member, Policy Strategy Group, International Panel of Judges for Youth Citizen Entrepreneurship Competition; Observer member, International Youth Taskforce for 2014 World Conference on Youth; Member, Advisory group panel on 50th Anniversary of the Commonwealth Secretariat. He was the Nigerian youth observer at the ECOWAS Parliament and the founder and pioneer president of the League for Democratic Youth.

He writes on international and national development issues, and he mentors and inspires young people to dream higher and realise their potentials.

He was voted the 2015 African Young Personality of by the Africa Youth Awards.

Ahmed Musa is a Nigerian professional footballer who plays as forward for Russian club CSKA Moscow and the Nigeria national team.

He is known for his pace, dribbling, composure, versatility and defensive effort.

He has been compared to Jesus Navas and Arjen Robben for his pace and his ability to cut inside and cause havoc; he is a good creator as well as corner specialist.

Musa is the first Nigerian to score more than once in a FIFA World Cup match after scoring twice against Argentina in the 2014 FIFA World Cup.

From 2010, he has made 58 appearances for the SenioNational Team scoring 11 Goals

On 8 July 2016, Musa moved to Leicester City for a club record £16.6 million.

Alain Nteff has been named CNN & Forbes Africa 30 Under 30 Entrepreneurs and was awarded the first ever Queen's Young Leaders Award by Queen Elizabeth II as GiftedMom targets over 5 million pregnant women and mothers across Africa by 2018.

He is also a ONE Young World 2014 Delegate and was named Africa's Top Social Entrepreneur in 2014 by the MasterCard Foundation and awarded the Anzisha Prize.

Alek Wek is a South Sudanese British model and designer who began her fashion career at the age of 18 in 1995. She has been hailed for her influence on the perception of beauty in the fashion industry.

She is from the Dinka ethnic group in South Sudan but fled to Britain in 1991 to escape the civil war in Sudan.

Since 2002, Wek has been an advisor to the U.S. Committee for Refugees Advisory Council, which helps to raise awareness about the situation in Sudan, as well as the plight of refugees worldwide and in July 2012, she returned to South Sudan with the UN Refugee Agency to highlight the stories of refugees returning from the north and the massive efforts needed to build and stabilise the country.

In 2007, she released an autobiography, entitled Alek: From Sudanese Refugee to International Supermodel, documenting her journey from a childhood of poverty in Sudan to the catwalks of Europe

Alengot rose out of the wilderness of obscurity after her father, Michael Oromait, died of hypertension on the morning of Saturday, July 21, this year. She succeeded him as MP for Usuk County.

Alengot is a First Year mass communication student at Uganda Christian University.

Blogger & Activist

Amira Yahyaoui is a Tunisian blogger and political activist.

Yahyaoui was born in Tunis and native of Ksar Hadada as the daughter of the Judge Mokhtar Yahyaoui who was dismissed after writing about the lack of justice in Tunisia.

Her cousin Zouhair Yahyaoui was an economist who founded the satirical website TUNeZINE. He died in 2005 after being persecuted and tortured by the government for his objections to censorship in Tunisia.

Amira fled to France and became a student there while participating in criticism of the Tunisian regime.

She was stateless for several years, but after the fall of President Ben Ali, she was able to gain a passport from the Tunisian embassy and returned to Tunisia, where she founded the NGO Al Bawsala ("The Compass" in Arabic). In 2014 she became a Meredith Greenberg Yale World Fellow and was awarded the conflict prevention prize by the Foundation Chirac.

Investigative Journalist, Tiger Eye PI

Anas Aremeyaw Anas is a Ghanaian investigative journalist born in the late 1970s whose real name is unknown by the public.

He is famous for utilizing his anonymity as a tool in his investigative arsenal, and very few people had seen his face.

A politically non-aligned multimedia journalist who specializes in print media and documentary, Anas focuses on issues of human rights and anti-corruption in Ghana and sub-Saharan Africa.

In September 2015 Anas premiered, in four showings, in front of a record-breaking over 6500 people, at the Accra International Conference Centre, his most significant undercover film "Ghana In The Eyes Of God". It exposed the widespread corruption within the Ghanaian Judiciary and graphically showed court workers like clerks and bailiffs connive with a number of respected Judges to influence court cases through bribes. Thirty-four judges and magistrates were caught on a hidden camera receiving enticements of money, goats, sheep and even foodstuffs.

Anas has also worked in Nigeria, Tanzania and other countries where he exposed various illegal dealings.

Inventor

At 24 Years, Anthony invented Shoes that recharge batteries.

The energy created by the movements of the body generates electricity that can thus recharge batteries of mobile phones or other electronic devices.

The shoe apparently has a very thin "crystal chip," perhaps a piezoelectric device, that generates power when the sole bends. It can charge phones via a long cable to a pocket while the user walks, or store power for later charging.

"This charger works using pressure, as you walk you generate pressure that in turn generates energy, once you have arrived where you were going you can now sit down and charge your mobile phone," Mutua told CNC World.

Marc Arthur ZANG is an Engineer in software design and computer Sciences and a Researcher in biomedical Engineering.


In 2010 he invented the Cardio-pad the first medical Touch tablet used to perform Heart examinations and remote diagnosis.



Abdul "Baba" Rahman is a Ghanaian professional footballer who plays as a left back for English club Chelsea and the Ghana national team.

Beginning his career at Dreams FC, he played in the Ghanaian Premier League with Asante Kotoko. In 2012, he signed for Bundesliga club Greuther Fürth, where he spent two seasons.

He then played for FC Augsburg before joining Chelsea in 2015 for a fee of £14 million, potentially rising to £22 million.

Rahman made his international debut in 2014 and was part of their squad which were runners-up at the 2015 Africa Cup of Nations.

On 16 August 2015, Rahman signed for Chelsea on a five-year deal for an undisclosed fee, reported to be an initial £14 million, rising to a potential fee of almost £22 million.

Born and raised on the tropical island of Mauritius, Barkha is a passionate advocate for the sustainable development of small island developing states and entertains a mild obsession about coral reefs. Following graduation, Barkha has been part of both civil society and government:

she launched a capacity-building project to harness youth voices through the power of social media for sustainable development ahead of the Rio+20 Conference on Sustainable Development.

Joining the Foreign Service of Mauritius as a diplomat, she made sure that environmental diplomacy was a key component of foreign policy, with issues such as climate finance, sustainable development of oceans, biodiversity being part of her areas of focus, particularly in the multilateral context.

The list which has representation from 27 African countries has a gender equity of 62 men and 38 women with the youngest being 14, considering the age limit of 40.

Selecting 10 of the most influential across 10 distinct categories, the number 100 represents the force of young people who are creating change and making sure it translates into making the lives of other people better.

The list which was compiled in consultation with a jury made up of young Africans based across the globe after weeks of public nomination represents hope for the continent and exhibits the potentials Africa has to become a global phenomenon.

On social media 87% of these young Africans are on Facebook with a combined following of 18,317,458 whiles 86% have 16,203,116 followers on twitter. (Data compiled on 15th July, 2016).

Prince Akpah, President of the organisation, reiterated the need for the continent to be inspired by its own success stories and hope the list will provide a great reference of motivation for most young people to take a step in creating a great future for themselves and Africa.
